1. **Look over the selection of cats via website and complete the adoption application below.**
2. **If approved, we'll arrange a kitty "Meet & Greet."**
3. **If we agree it's a good match**, you will receive a Welcome letter and a copy of the Adoption Contract. A delivery time will be arranged.
4. **Delivery Day.** Be prepared to spend the entire day and evening home with your new pet. This is their big day!! The Adoption Contract will be completed and signed at this time and the adoption fee will be collected. You may pay by cash, check payable to Lifeline for Pets, Zelle (thedaisywillow@msn.com), or credit card (use the Donate button on our website).
5. **2 Week Trial Period.** During or after that time, together we will determine whether you will keep the pet or return it to us. We want it to be a good fit.
Adoption Fees cover vaccinations, de-worming, FELV/FIV tested, vet check, spay/neuter, microchip. If it's a "courtesy post," fee and requirements may differ. Be sure to inquire.
